## CLASSROOM NEWS - Hedgehogs

We hope you all had a lovely Summer. Despite the weather, we have been able to enjoy the outside space with lots of water play, sand play and lots of trips to the park.

We are now ready for the beginning of a new term, so just a reminder of a few things. With the weather being changeable at this time of year, please make sure your child is dressed appropriately and has both warmer and cooler spare clothes in their bag so we can cater for all weathers. Please also bring in wet suits just in case we have some rain. If you have not done so already, please can we have some nappy cream bought from home. We will then label this and keep at nursery.

Our theme for September is Our Body/Food. We will be exploring our sensory tables using different textures of food using our hands and feet and focusing on our face and body parts, singing our core song 'Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes' and doing body painting on different parts of the body. We will also enjoy looking at our ourselves in the mirror and dancing and moving our bodies to the sounds. We will be looking at the different fruits we can make to use in a smoothie. Our other core song will be 'Miss Polly had a Dolly'.

Our theme for October is Autumn with our core songs being 'Big Red Tractor' and 'Incy Wincy Spider'. We will be enjoying our woodland walks running through all the leaves, feeding the birds their bird foods, and making the most of our surrounding areas. We will be filling our sensory tray with different textured sensory resources, such as pinecones, coloured leaves, and conkers. We will be finger painting, making our own tress using different colours for the leaves and making hedgehog pictures using forks and paint to make different marks.

We will be focusing a lot on this half term getting to know all the children, settling them, learning their individual interests and their routine. We are looking forward to watching the children learn and grown throughout the year.
