## CLASSROOM NEWS-CUBS

Hello Everyone!

We hope you have had a fantastic summer. We are all excited to be back and looking forward to the term ahead. We have lots of lovely activities, adventures and experiences planned for your children to enjoy.

In Cubs, we will be introducing French as part of our group time sessions. We will start with learning numbers, colours and animals and progress on as children learn.

We are also going to be introducing Beat Baby (a small cuddly toy). Beat Baby helps with the learning of:

- language structures
- phonological awareness
- awareness of the different sounds and elements of words.
- a sense of rhyme, rhythm and alliteration.
- listening skills

It is also designed to help children emotionally with both the teaching and learning of communication and social skills. It will hopefully become the children's new friend, through stimulating and encouraging participation and interaction.

Beat Baby will go home with a child each week and spend some time with you. Beat Baby comes with a book you can write in and add photos to show what you have been up to. The children then bring Beat Baby back and we talk about what adventure the baby has been on.

There has been a big push from the Government about oral health in young children. We have decided to make sure we include this in our planning from now on and if you are happy with your children to brush their teeth at nursery, we would like to start brushing our teeth after lunch each day. We have bought the children their own tooth brushes which will be stored safely and hygienically.

We will carry on with our Woodland Walks as the children love to be out exploring. They get so much out of it and it is lots of fun.

Please continue to send in photos of what you have been up to outside of nursery and/or family celebrations. The children enjoy seeing them and talking about them at group times.

Whilst we are still having nice weather, please remember sun cream to be put on before the children arrive at nursery and to bring in a bottle so we can reapply if needed. We do have sun hats so you don't need to bring them. As the weather changes, please start to bring in warmer clothes. We find that layers are best. Please remember to name any of your child's belongings as this is really helpful to us.
