We hope our families have managed to have a restful and exciting Jubilee weekend. Please feel free to share any photos through Tapestry so we can talk about it with your child and show the other children at group time. The speech and language within our group has come on tremendously since they first came through from Hedgehogs.

As we have come into the month of June our theme has now changed to 'animals'. If anyone has a small pet that could be shown to the children that would be amazing! We will look at many books featuring animals and looking around our environment to find sheep, horses and evidence of nocturnal animals within the hedgerows.

Our core stories this month will be 'Monkey Puzzle' by Julia Donaldson and 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell. We will also be singing songs like Leo the Lion, Alice the Camel and 3 Cheeky Monkeys. We will then finish the term with a theme of Summer/Seaside, exploring sand and water play, looking for signs of summer on our walks and our final core story will be 'Spot goes on Holiday'.

We do predict much water play as the weather warms up. Please ensure your children have a **full change of clothes** as well as their wellies so they can pop those on to save their shoes getting wet. Please also remember that all children should arrive at nursery with an 8-10 hour sunscreen applied. Children also need their own labelled sunscreen at nursery with prior written consent for staff to apply it. Also a reminder that if you send a sunhat to nursery it needs to be named and labelled and there should be no open toed sandals worn for safety reasons.
